Activity #2. Given the root of the tree, determine if it is perfect.

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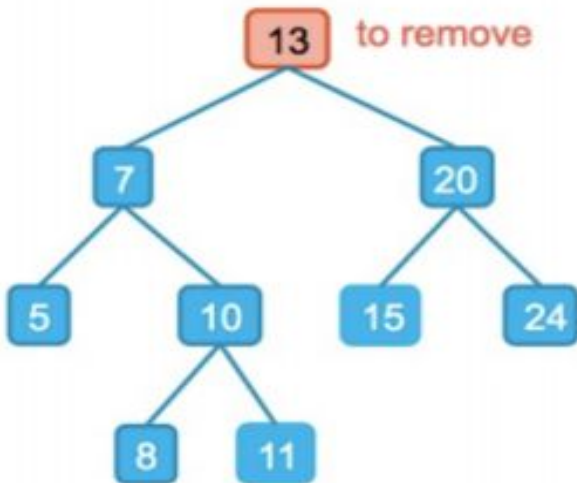
Activity #2. Given the root of the tree, determine if it is perfect.
