When working on assignments, students may consult one another; but are then required to list the names of all students with whom they discussed an assignment on their submitted work. Additionally, each pair of students is expected to write up their own solutions to the homework. Unnatural similarities among students' submissions with other students whose names are not listed OR extreme similarities among submissions from two different pairs will be forwarded to the Dean of the College's office for review, to assess whether or not there has been a violation of Brown's Academic Code.
