Setup

- If you are new to Gradescope, make an account with either your Brown or CS email.
- Click **Add Course**; the entry code is **MJ2B74**.
- Navigate to **Account** → **Edit Account**
- Change your “real name” to an anonymous ID. We recommend using either uugenerator.net (and choosing the first few characters) or your Banner ID. Change your “student ID” to your Banner ID.
 - This is very important, as we use this method to maintain anonymity in grading.
 - **Fill out [this Google Form](#) to submit your ID before turning in the first assignment.**
 - If you have a Gradescope account under a different name for a different course, feel free to create a second account using your CS email.

Handin

- In order for us to grade a written assignment, it must meet the following requirements:
 - It is typeset in LaTeX submitted as a PDF.
 - No two problems are on the same page (sub-problems are fine).
 - It lists the Banner IDs of the submitter, their partner, and any collaborators.
 - The problems are correctly associated with the pages in Gradescope.
