

Interactive grading sessions will be spread out across the week following an assignment due date. Failure to attend an interactive grading session will result in an automatic 20% deduction from that project's score.

Projects Graded Interactively:

- Every student is graded on 3 assignments total at random selection.

Grading Session Setup:

- Grading meetings will be hosted on Zoom and generally range from 5-15 minutes depending on the complexity of the project.
- Students can sign up for a 1 hour availability window within which they will be seen by a TA one-on-one. During this 1 hour availability window, students will join a queue and will be seen, first come first serve.
- Each question will be graded on a scale of 0 to 1 (no credit, partial credit, full credit), and you should expect to be asked several questions during the meeting. We are looking to see that students have understood the code that they have submitted and the concepts and justifications behind the design.
 - Students who fail the grading session will have their assignment flagged for additional review and receive a 20% penalty on their project score.

Accommodations/Make Up Sessions:

- If students miss their place in the queue and there is time left in the grading session, they may rejoin the queue to be seen.
- If you miss your place in the queue and do not rejoin the queue in time, you will receive a 10% penalty on your overall project score and must sign up for a make-up session slot.
- Students will not receive a 10% penalty if they are granted accommodations by the professor to attend a make-up session.
- Missing and failing to make up a grading session will count as an automatic fail and will result in the 20% penalty.
- Make-up interactive grading sessions forgo the queue system and will be booked by appointment. Students who are late to or miss their make-up grading session will not be accepted and are not eligible to sign up for another session (unless under outstanding circumstances and granted accommodations).
