CAPSTONE: A capstone is a course normally taken in the student's *last undergraduate year* in which the student (or group of students) uses a significant portion of her or his undergraduate education, broadly interpreted, in studying some current topic in depth to produce a culminating artifact such as a paper or software project. The title and abstract of the artifact, along with the student's and faculty-sponsor's names, will be placed in the CS website. The inclusion of a relevant image or system diagram is strongly encouraged. Note that completion of an honors thesis satisfies the capstone requirement. The project is not considered complete until the title and abstract have been submitted to the CS Faculty and Student Affairs Manager (fasam@cs.brown.edu).
