### CSCI 1300 Capstone: Responsive Redesign Jenny Tan


#### **Abstract**

I evaluated, redesigned and implemented a website for Cheng Du Taste, a Chinese restaurant in Providence. First, I identified and analyzed usability and accessibility issues in the current website. 




