
Click on dashed line and press the delete key on the keyboard.




Click to add title

1. Click on the “text box” icon on the bottom left of the screen





2. Click on slide, and drag box open. Start Typing.

Edit Text




Select Text then:



italicize, etc..




Modify Pictures

But how do I change the size of the picture?

Can I move it around?

Rotate it?

Click on the picture to get white dots around it. On the top, there should be a green dot.



Rotate: click on the green dot and drag the picture in a circle

Resize: click on white dot and drag to new size

But wait, you can do that with text boxes too!

Click on the text and

drag the green dot

and you can rotate a text box

Modify Pictures

What do all these buttons do?



Increases or decreases the brightness of a picture



Changes the picture from grayscale to color, or to black and white, or washes it out




Modify Pictures

What do all these buttons do?




Headless Krista
Side-winder Krista


Crops the pictures: cuts out the parts you don't want
Rotates the Picture



Get a super-fly background



Click on the Design Button



And then click on a background

You can change the color the same way you changed the color of the blank background! Right click!

Autoshapes

How do I get arrows, squares, circles and other “autoshapes”?


Choose one of these (or one off of the “AutoShapes” drop menu) and drag your mouse to “draw” it on the screen.




Autoshapes

Make your lines dashed




Add 3-D effects






Animate

Right click on an object (like a picture or text)



Choose "Custom Animation"




Animate

Click “Add Effect”

Then choose the effect you want.

If you want two objects (pictures or text boxes) to do the same thing at the same time, before you click “Add Effect” click on one of them, and then hold down the shift key as you click the other(s).




Animate

Once you have chosen some effects for your object, you can pick the order in which they happen.


1. Click on an event

2. Then press the reorder buttons to move it higher or lower in the list



Animate

You can choose the speed of the animation and whether you want it to start when you click, or after a certain time, or after the last “animation.”
